Youth group has put together a list of food items needed to make their yearly Easter Breakfast possible.

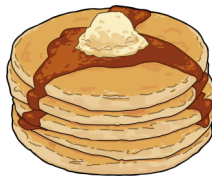
If you would like to donate a few food items on their list please sign up!
