The pastor will also offer a blessing to any unconfirmed children who desire it.)

His real Body and Blood come to us in, with and under the bread and wine. Not only are our sins forgiven through this meal, our faith is strengthened, and the Holy Spirit guides us to be better and more effective servants to God.
