Christmas Greetings from Members to Members
Greetings will be inserted in the December 21st bulletins. This long-standing custom originated when members decided to convey Season's Greetings to fellow members via a special insert, donating what would otherwise have been spent on postage to a separate fund. Sign your name on the sign-up sheet in the Narthex or call the office to sign-up. **Deadline is December 14th** in order to be included on the Greeting, Print your name(s) exactly as you would like to have them put on the Christmas Greeting. You may turn your donation in to the office or place it in the offering plate and designate "Christmas Greeting" on the memo line. Payment can be made online on our website. **Recipient of the Greeting Funds will be Christian Senior Ministries.**

Who is "Christian Senior Ministries, Inc.?" (CSM) started in late 2000 collectively by area LCMS churches. It was established to minister to people in nursing homes and assisted living facilities in the DeKalb, IL area, as many of these residents did not have regular access to God's Word. CSM currently serves in eleven facilities, reaching around 125 people per week. Weekly services are held at the facilities including a message/sermon, prayers, hymn singing and blessing. Residents sometimes have questions that may require additional one on one time. Two pastors primarily minister at the locations with additional pastors and laity serving when substitutes are needed. Volunteer pianists also serve. CSM is a Recognized Service Organization (RSO) of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod.



Poinsettia Plants for Christmas

Once again this year we are planning on decorating the sanctuary with poinsettia plants for Christmas services. If you would like to purchase one or more, call the office to sign-up, or sign up in the narthex as well. You can

indicate if you will be taking your plant home or if you would like to have it taken to a shut-in. There will be a choice of marble, red or white.
