Delivery involves:

1. Arriving at Meals on Wheels headquarters around 10:45am. (Located on the corner of Peace and Bethany Road).
2. Obtaining prepacked carriers to place in your vehicle.
3. Using their carefully designed route maps to deliver meals to shut-ins.

Returning carriers to the headquarters. You are finished in about an hour or so. This is a fun task that is very well organized. 
LWML SOUP & SANDWICH ASH WEDNESDAY DINNER will be offered on Wednesday, February 18 from 5:15—6:30p.m.
